WHAT POLICE OFFICERS DO... Police Officers protect people and property in cities, towns and rural areas. They make sure that people obey laws and rules of safety. Some police officers direct traffic. Others help prevent crimes, investigate crimes, and arrest people who break the law. Troopers, or highway patrol officers, issue traffic tickets to drivers who disobey laws. They also help at the scene of accidents.

SCHOOL SUBJECTS: Reading, Writing, Physical Education, Psychology

SKILLS AND PERSONALITY TRAITS: Honesty, good judgment, responsibility, inter-personal skills, supervisory and leadership qualities.

RECOMMENDED EDUCATION AND TRAINING: Requirements are fairly strict. Usually candidates must pass many tests to prove they are qualified to be police officers. These tests include written exams as well as of physical strength, dexterity and endurance. The medical histories of candidates are checked carefully to eliminate those who have medical conditions that would hinder their work. All candidates are put through background checks, to make sure they are U.S. citizens and that they have no history of criminal involvement or convictions. The majority of police departments require applicants to have at least a high school education. In some cases, college training is required. Many colleges and junior colleges now offer programs in law enforcement, police work, and police administration. Candidates accepted by the police forces enter a period of special training. This training may last three to six months or longer. Training include a mixture of classroom work in local, state and federal laws, physical fitness training, firearm instruction, and other practical training with legal procedures for enforcing the law.

EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE 21ST CENTURY: According to the U.S. Department of Labor, police officer in 1996 earned an annual average salary of \$34,700. Those in supervisory positions earned median salaries of \$41,200 a year (with a low of \$22,500 and a high of over \$64,500). Sheriffs and other law enforcement officers earned median annual salaries of \$26,700. A police officer's salary may range widely based on geographic locations. Police departments in the West and the North generally pay more than those in the South. Most police officers receive periodic salary increases. Police departments generally pay a special compensation to cover the cost of uniforms and usually provide any equipment required such as firearms and handcuffs. Overtime pay may be given for certain work shifts or emergency duty. Jobs for police officers will increase about as fast as the average through 2006. This occupation has very low turnover rate. However, new positions will open as current officers retire, leave the force, or move into higher positions. Retirement ages are relatively low compared to other occupations. Many officers retire while in their forties and pursue a second career. In response to increasing crime rates, some police departments across the country are expanding the number of patrol officers; however, budget problems faced by many municipalities may limit growth. There is a growing demand for women and minorities—as well as bilinguals—in law enforcement. There is also a need for officers to work in special fields, including drug narcotics.
